Remember the study process for the translation lists:

1. Listen to the sentences in English and Spanish while you read them at the same time. When you hear the sentence in English, catch the meaning. When you hear the sentence again in Spanish, think of the meaning you have caught. Try to "deploy" or "roll out" the meaning you captured from the sentence in English, on the sentence in Spanish that you are hearing now.

Go away! Go for a walk with your headphones! And continue this process:

- 2. Listen to the sentence in English
- 3. Then pause immediately the audio and try to say it aloud in Spanish.
- **4.** Then resume the audio (the sentence in Spanish will be played) and check if you did it right when it is pronounced in Spanish.
- 5. Repeat again and again until you can say the sentences correctly
